

Make a Wrist Pincushion

Beginners Project

Step by step tutorial



Make an elasticated, sawdust filled pincushion that can be worn on the wrist.

You Will Need

Fabric 10" x 15"
Iron on interfacing 6" x 6"
Wadding 6" x 6"
Thick Card 2.5" x 2.5"
Elastic 3/4' x 7"
Safety Pin

Scissors
Pins
Sawdust
Needle
Thread
Sewing machine



Step 1



Using the template,
cut out the pieces
required

Step 2



Iron the interfacing to
the largest circle.

Step 3



Fold the strap fabric
in half, right sides
together. Sew 1 1/2"
from the top to 1 1/2"
from the end with a
1/2" seam allowance.
Trim to 1/4"

Step 4



Using the safety pin,
turn the strap right
sides out. Press seam
to the middle.

Step 5



Sew the two ends
together with 1/2"
seam making a loop.

Step 6



Thread the elastic
through the strap
using the safety pin.

Step 7



Sew the elastic together and hand sew the opening shut.

Step 8



Place the wadding onto the large circle and hand sew a running stitch near the edge. Fill with sawdust.

Step 9



Draw the stitches together to form a ball. Shape and secure with stitches.

Step 10



Hand sew running stitches around the smaller circle and draw around the card. Secure with stitches.

Step 11



With the seam on the inside of the strap, hand sew the card to the elastic strap.

Step 12







Now securely hand sew the ball shape to the card.



You now have a comfortable and practical pincushion on hand to help you with your sewing tasks.
